<u>September 15- Homecoming!!</u>

- This week you will discuss Homecoming. Freshmen have never been to Homecoming before, so they will definitely be confused and curious on what to do, where to be, and the rules.
- This is the week where you will vote on Homecoming Nominees. Make sure your freshmen clearly circle/highlight one girl and one boy from the list of nominees.
- After you have finished voting, collect the ballots. Next, give a brief description on the start of Homecoming, give a little background on how it all started.
- Discuss the following with your Freshmen about Homecoming:
 - O When and where: The dance will be held on Saturday, Sept. 19 at the South High school auxiliary gym from 8-11 pm. The game is on Friday, Sept. 18 at the Panther Stadium beginning at 7 pm.
 - O <u>Crowning</u>: Voting took place during advisories. Crowning of the female candidates will take place at the Football game on the 18th during half time. Males will be crowned at the dance.
 - O <u>Tickets</u>: Tickets are on sale this week during lunch shifts. Cost is \$5.
 - O What to bring: Bring your student ID to the dance. You will NOT be allowed in the dance if you do not have your ID. Bring your ticket as well.
 - O <u>What to wear:</u> This dance is formal, so please stay appropriate with what you are choosing to wear. There will be administration at the dance, just to let you know.
 - O No grinding
- After you discuss all of Homecoming, ASK IF ANYONE HAS QUESTIONS.
 ANSWER THEM.
- Next you will play a game with the class.

This game has the potential for some laughs with your students. Have each student take out two scrap pieces of paper. On one piece of paper, each person should write a question that begins with the word 'why'. Then on the second piece of paper, each person should answer his or her question starting with the word 'because'. Then collect all the why's in one pile and all the becauses in another. Mix up each pile and then read one why card with one because card. The combinations can be very funny, and then after reading all the random match ups you can have your students match the correct answers with the correct questions
